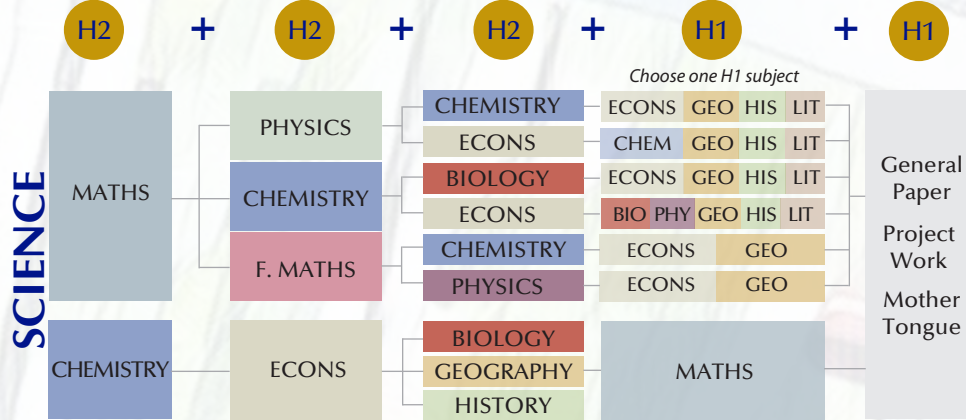
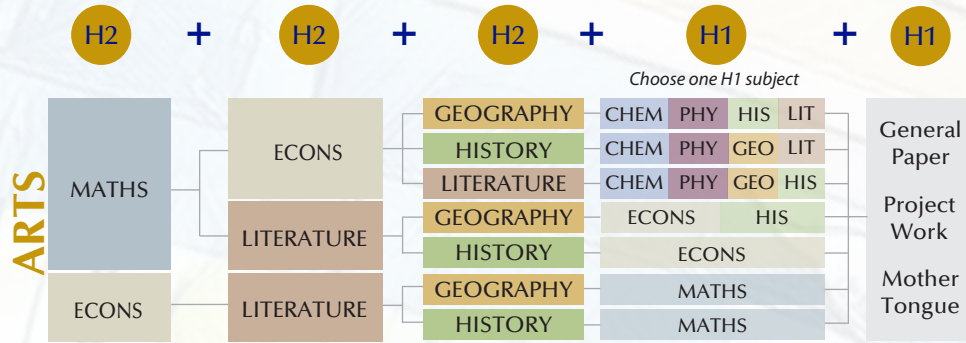


Subject Combinations offered at CJC



- General Paper and Project Work are compulsory subjects. *Students offering Knowledge & Inquiry will not be required to offer General Paper.*
- Students who have taken and not achieved a grade of 'D7' or better in O-Level Higher Mother Tongue Languages **must** take H1 Mother Tongue.
- All students who obtain a grade of 'D7' or better in their O-Level Higher Mother Tongue Language are **not** allowed to replace H1 Mother Tongue Language with another content subject.
- Students who are **offering H2 Mathematics** must have obtained a grade of '**C6**' or **better** in O-Level Additional Mathematics.
- To qualify for 4 H2 subjects, students must obtain 10 points or better for their L1R5 aggregate ('raw score') **and** 8 points or better in their 4 relevant O-Level subjects.
- Students who are offering H1 or H2 Physics, Chemistry or Biology must have obtained a grade of 'C6' or better in the relevant O-Level subject (either as Pure Science or Combined Science).
- Students who have taken O-Level Combined Science, without any other Pure Sciences, are eligible for **only ONE H2 Science Subject**. Eligible students may opt to take the 2nd science subject at H1 if they have grades of 'A1' in **all** these 3 subjects: Mathematics, Additional Mathematics and Combined Science.
